Akaal Primary School will operate an extended school day with core curriculum time and time before and after school for enrichment. Breakfast Club:

8:00 - 8:30am

We will offer Breakfast Club to ensure that all pupils have a good start to the day and that working parents are fully supported.

We see breakfast as a vital meal to enhance pupils' attention and good learning. Breakfast Club will provide a healthy breakfast with a balanced diet for all who wish to attend.



After School Club:

3:30 - 6:00pm

After-school Clubs will provide a safe and happy environment for learning and play.

This is particularly relevant for parents whose working commitments mean that they are not able to be at home at the end of the normal school day.

Extra-Curricular Activities:

3:30 - 4:30pm

The extra-curricular activities will include a range of heritage, culture, language, dance and music options.
